Breast Imaging Radiologist

The new 10,000 square foot dedicated Breast Center is a state-of-the-art facility, fully digital with PACS, including FFDM, Ultrasound, dedicated LORAD stereotactic biopsy table and new open bore MRI with Dynacad. Paperless environment features MagView mammography reporting system. The Breast Radiologists perform all imaging and minimally invasive biopsies and have an integrated, collaborative practice with the Breast Surgery staff of the Center. We are active participants in a multidisciplinary team approach to breast disease. The Breast Center was one of the original recipients of the ACR Breast Imaging Center of Excellence Award.

Penn State University College of Medicine is located in Hershey, Pennsylvania, which is 9 miles from the state capital of Harrisburg. The campus is home to Penn State University's 500-bed tertiary care academic health center, which is currently experiencing impressive growth. In addition to the new outpatient facility in which the Breast Center resides, the new Penn State Cancer Institute recently opened in 2009. The dedicated freestanding Children Hospital construction is nearing completion.

Eligible candidates must have a keen interest in teaching, have completed an accredited radiology residency, fellowship training or equivalent experience and possess, or be able to obtain, a Pennsylvania State Medical License. Board certification is required. The level of faculty appointment and salary will be commensurate with the Breast Imaging experience and training.
